Fun with Sight Words!

Here are some fun, hands-on games to play that will have your preschooler recognizing sight words in no time!



Puddle Jumpin'

Cut out "puddles" from blue paper. Write sight words on 5 of the puddles. Give your kiddo a sight word to puddle-jump to! He or she could even wear rain boots!



Color Sight Word Scavenger Hunt

Take out the color word sight words from your flashcards set. Spread them out on the floor. Challenge your preschooler to find objects of those colors and place them on the correct color word.



Spell it with Magnets or Clothespins

Hang five sight word flashcards on your fridge at a time. Give your child alphabet magnets and see if they can spell out the word underneath the flashcard with the magnets. Review the words as they spell them.

If you don't have magnets, try a similar approach using clothespins. Write the letters of the sight words on clothespins and ask your little one to clip the clothespin letters onto the sight word flashcards to form the words.
